

## INJURY RESEARCH PROGRAM FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS SUMMER 2011



Conduct your own research under the supervision and guidance of internationally-known faculty researchers. More than 40 of our students have published their research.

### GOALS

Participants in the Injury Research Program will:

- Learn important research, statistical, and data analysis skills
- Learn how to write a scientific manuscript
- Complete a manuscript as first author based on their research and submit it for publication

### DETAILS

- Four students will be selected from among the applicants
- The training period is 8 weeks. Students will work 40 hours per week from June 13 - August 5, 2011
- Each selected student will receive a \$3,000 stipend
- Free housing is available near the Injury Research Center for visiting students
